



DID YOU KNOW?

Each CRP conservation practice, e.g. CP2, CP21, CP23A, CP25, CP42, has a different set of specifications that the seed mix must meet. Standards differ between states.

These standards determine things such as:

- Seeds per square foot
- Number of species
- Proportion of grasses and flowers.

The seed mix information provided with your contract is an example. There are many ways to design your mix to meet the requirements of the CRP program.

We can help determine which native seed mix will work best for your CRP planting.

Your land is enrolled in CRP. Now what?

The Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) pays a yearly rental payment in exchange for farmers removing environmentally sensitive land from agricultural production and planting species that will improve environmental quality.

Step 1: Consider your CRP goals

Determine why you're planting native species and the purpose you want your native restoration to serve.

Step 2: Choose your CRP mix

Consider a Pre-designed CRP Mix

Our pre-designed CRP mixes meet the requirements of your state's CRP program.

Ask us for a price list and consider your options.

OR

Consider a Custom Designed Mix

Bring the mix specifications provided by your NRCS office or simply tell us what you're looking for.

We'll make recommendations based on species availability & price.

Step 3: Seek approval for the final mix

We design all of our mixes to meet the requirements of the CRP program. However, we have found that the state-determined rules are often interpreted differently in each county. We recommend seeking approval for your mix prior to placing an order.

Step 4: Place your order

We'll need a few details to finalize your order:

- Shipping or Pick Up**
Seed may be picked up or delivered.
- Date needed**
We can hold your order in our warehouse until you need it.
- Payment**
All orders must be pre-paid unless prior credit has been approved.
- Sales Tax**
CRP seed qualifies as a tax-exempt purchase. The state's sales tax exemption certificate must be filled out and returned.
- Mix Instructions**
Blended all together, small seed separate from large seed, or grasses separate from wildflowers.
